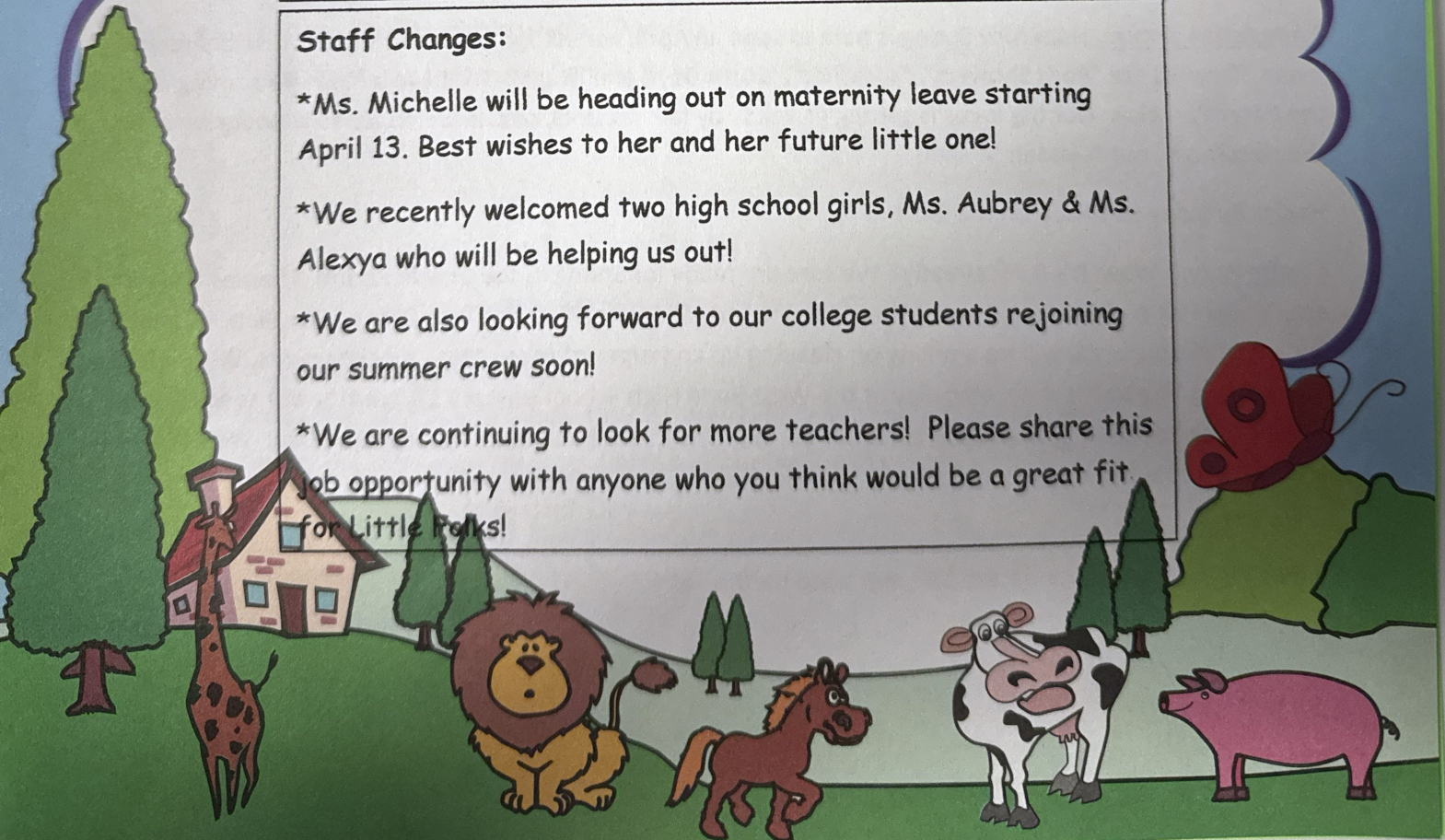
April 2026 Newsletter
